

### Days of the Week & Time of Day Lesson

- Run “Morning Meeting”
  - “Morning Meeting” at Mandan Middle was actually done in the afternoon, but was the same idea as a typical morning meeting.
  - Discuss the day and month it was and pick the date on the calendar.
  - Sing a song about the days of the week.
  - Recite the months of the year in order.
  - Count to 100.
  - Dress a paper person for the weather.
  - Ask students about their weekend.
- Move to table.
  - Recite days of the week again.
  - Pick a day of the week and write it on the board.
  - Have students read the day of the week and say the day that comes before and the day that comes after.
  - Repeat for about 5 minutes, or until focus is lost.
- Time of Day
  - Use game printed (picture of activity, i.e., going to bed, and options of morning, afternoon, or night underneath)
  - I do: the first card, I will read and pick the correct time of day
  - We do: the second card we will do together
  - They do: the students will take turns picking the correct time of day.
